ABANDONED MOTOR VEHICLE

REPORT OF SALE REQUIREMENTS

(OCGA § 40-11-6)

After satisfaction of the lien, (meaning only if the sales price is more than the amount of the lien in the court order) the person selling such motor vehicle shall:

1. Within 30 days after the date of the sale;
2. Provide the Clerk of the Court with a copy of the bill of sale as provided to the purchaser;
3. Pay to the Clerk of Court all sums collected over and above the amount of the court ordered lien except as allowed by a Notice of Overage approved by the court.; and
4. Provide the clerk with a report that includes:
 - The style of the case granting the lien foreclosure;
 - The amount of the court ordered lien;
 - The date of the public auction;
 - The amount received for the vehicle at the public sale
 - The city (if any) and county in which the public auction was held and the motor vehicle was sold;
 - That the vehicle came into the possession of the person creating the lien at the request of:
 - A private party
 - A police officer of the City of _____
 - A _____ County sheriff, deputy sheriff or police officer
 - A member of the Georgia State Patrol or other employee of the state of Georgia
5. If you are asking for credit for expenses and costs incurred after the issuance of the Lien Foreclosure Order you must file **BOTH** the Notice of Overage From the Sale of an An Abandoned Motor Vehicle and Claim for Costs and Fees incurred After the issuance of the Lien Order and the AMV Report of Vehicle Sale.
