

**STANDING ORDER GOVERNING EX-PARTE TEMPORARY  
PROTECTIVE ORDERS SET TO EXPIRE BEFORE JUNE 12, 2020**

For the duration of the Judicial Emergency declared March 14, 2020, by the Chief Justice of the Georgia Supreme Court, the DeKalb County Chief of Superior Court Judge, and any subsequent extensions thereof, including the May 11, 2020, extension; all Ex-Parte Orders set to expire on or before June 12, 2020, are hereby extended, tolled or otherwise continued until June 12, 2020. Said Orders are to be enforced according to all terms originally stated in the Order on the date it was entered. Accordingly, law enforcement shall continue strictly enforcing any and all violations of said Orders.
