

For the duration of the Judicial Emergency declared by the Chief Justice of the Georgia Supreme Court, the DeKalb County Chief Superior Court Judge and any subsequent extensions thereof, all Ex-Parte Orders set to expire on or before November 9, 2020, are hereby extended, tolled or otherwise continued until November 9, 2020. Said Orders are to be enforced according to all terms originally stated in the Order on the date it was entered. Accordingly, law enforcement shall continue strictly enforcing any and all violations of said Orders.
