STANDING ORDER CONCERNING DISPOSSESSORY BULK FILINGS

Effective November 18, 2019, parties filing more than five (5) dispossessionary cases simultaneously, with the exception of writs, will be considered a bulk filer. Bulk filers must use FivePoints Solutions, a vendor capable of filing large numbers of cases electronically through eFileGA. Filings should be submitted through <https://efile.myfivepoint.com/ga/> and questions regarding the filing process should be directed to 803-951-2094. FivePoints Solutions and eFileGA have separate processing fees for accessing and using the systems.

Parties may also file cases individually at the courthouse using the Public Access Terminal located in the DeKalb County Clerk's Office, thus avoiding electronic filing fees.
